## **OVERDUE SALARY INCREMENTS**

The Circular is reminding all on Cabinet's decision in its meeting No. 19/18 dated 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 that all applications for backdated claims inclusive of salary increments had to be dealt with by concerned Ministries/Agencies and Cabinet. NCS A. 11 had been abolished from NCS thus the claims beyond one year as a result of the administrative oversights as had been the common rationale be processed for Cabinet's approval.

- 2. Another equally important matter is that Senior Responsible Officers are kindly requested to sign 'under first sight' on any current salary increment application for an employee to ensure that the concerned SRO is fully aware on staff salary matters.
